Frequently asked questions...

- **Does the laundry have to be washed before or separately with a conventional detergent?**

Textile Wash is a detergent and used like that. That means you do your laundry only with this detergent.

- **How much Textile Wash do I have to use for 5kg laundry?**

You need 30-45ml per washing (depending on water hardness).

- **Do I have to use Textile Wash as a detergent or as a fabric softener?**

Textile wash is used as liquid detergent and can be put into the drum or into the drawer (detergent side).

- **Is it sufficient to wash a ski suit with Textile Wash or do I have to spray on Textil Proof as soon as it is dry?**

Textile Wash only washes, there is no impregnation effect. You first have to wash, when the suit is dry spray on the TextileProof impregnation.

There are diverse washing impregnations on the market. They 1. impregnate very badly and 2. the inside and the outside of the garment. An impregnation on the inside destroys the breathability of the textile membranes completely.

- **What do I need this product for if it does not impregnate? What are the advantages?**

A common detergent contains fillers. Those are not relevant for the washing but are extremely negative for the **functional clothing**. You buy functional clothing in order to have breathability. This is made through membranes. While washing with common detergents the fillers get into the membranes and block them. The breathability now is destroyed and you will be sweating.

The products TextileWash + TextileProof complement one another excellently and are perfectly adjusted in function.
